He was a bank clerk prior to the war, and also a pre-war member of the 1/4th Battalion, Welsh Regiment. He was mobilised in August 1914, joining the battalion at Pembroke Dock. Norman was accidentally killed by a bullet fired by a sentry, whilst asleep in his tent at Scoveston Camp, Pembroke on 18 October 1914, aged 21; buried at Cardigan Cemetery.

David was born in Cardigan. He lived with his wife Bella Davies in Swansea prior to the war and enlisted there into the 6th Battalion, Welsh Regiment. David was posted to France in the late summer of 1916 and was initially posted to the 16th Welsh, then to the 17th Welsh. He was then posted to the 1st/6th Welsh, which was the pioneer battalion to the 1st Division. David was killed by shellfire when the battalion was at work road-building and constructing trench-board tracks to the north-east of Ypres on 15 November 1917. He has no known grave and is commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium. He does not appear to be commemorated locally.

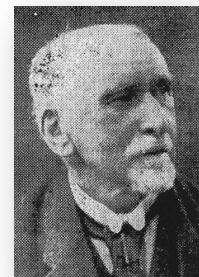

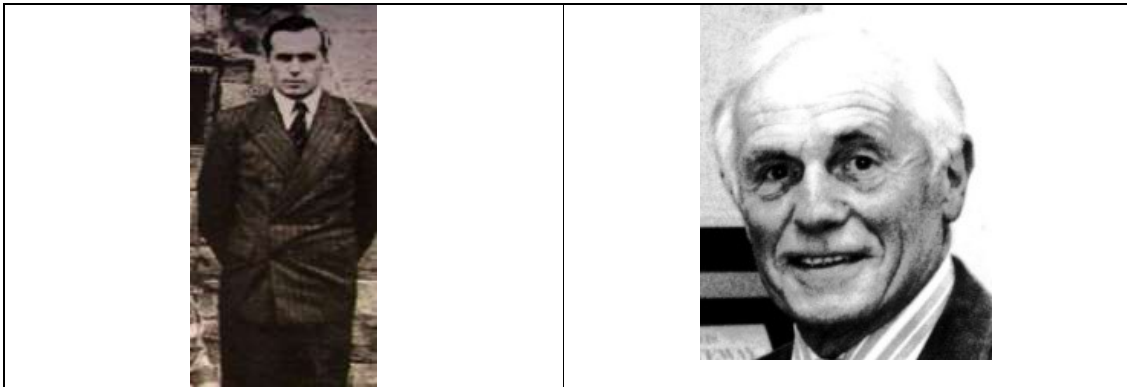
