Were held on Thursday, in the council chamber (before Messrs. James Williams, mayor, and T. Davies) when James Bateman, servant in husbandry, David Harries, saddler, both of St. Mary St., Cardigan were charged on the information of Police constable J. Richards with being in the Lamb Inn, Finch's Sq., during prohibited hours on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> ult. Defendants pleaded guilty, and the bench taking a merciful view of the case, they were fined 1s each and costs.

Enoch Davies, labourer Upper Mwldan was charged by PC Jones with being drunk and riotous in Pendre on the 19<sup>th</sup> ult. Fined 5s and costs [1.12.1877 *Western Mail*]

He served as a Pilot with 50 Squadron, Royal Air Force, which was a heavy bomber squadron, equipped with the Avro Lancaster Mark I, based at RAF Skellingthorpe. Evan was killed when his Lancaster was shot down over France on 13 February 1943. He was 32 years old, and is buried at Gavres Communal Cemetery, France.

He enlisted at Bridgend into the Welsh Regiment and was posted to France in the late summer of 1916, joining the 16th Battalion, Welsh Regiment, which was attached to 115 Brigade, 38th (Welsh) Division. He probably joined up with the battalion following the divisions move into the canal bank sector north of Ypres, which it would hold until launching its offensive on the Pilckem Ridge on 31 July 1917. Gwilym was killed in action on Pilckem Ridge at

Davies, John Daniel, Second Engineer, Mercantile Marine. John was born at Grangetown, [**or Queen's Tce perhaps??**] the son of Daniel Davies.

In August 1917 he married Mary Sarah Morris, and she set up the family home at Capel Llangeitho, Tregaron, Cardigan.

John served in the Mercantile Marine as engineer aboard the SS Santa Amalia, a London registered cargo ship. On 28 December 1917, when 30 miles from Malin Head, Ireland she was torpedoed without warning and sunk by the German submarine U-19. John was among 43 men whose lives were lost that day. He was 28 years old, and is commemorated on the Tower Hill Memorial, London.

John Davies (Ossian Dyfed) was born in Ossian House, Eben's Lane in 1852, the son of Phoebe Davies who died in 1857 at the early age of 29 years. He began his career as a carpenter, then he worked as a printer and journalist on the *Tivy-side*. He began to compete in Bethsaida Eisteddfod in 1868, when he first used the name Ossian Dyfed. He won over 50 eisteddfodic prizes.

He left Cardigan to work on the *Brecon Express*, *Y Darian* and the *Mellten* (Merthyr Tudful). He returned to Cardigan and attended D. M. Palmer's Academy before entering Brecon Memorial College in 1873. He was a minister with the Independents in Llanelli (Tabernacl), and during his ministry the membership increased to 400.

He moved to Swansea and membership increased from 60 to 230. He moved then to Tollington Park, London where the membership doubled within three years. He then moved to Richmond Hill, Bournemouth, and finally to Paddington, London, 1897–1903.

He married Elizabeth Davies, Llandeilo in 1881, and they had a son Sidney and a daughter Gwladys. His brother was the Revd. T. Eynon Davies.

He published two volumes of sermons: *Old but [yet?] ever new*, 1904 and *The Dayspring from on High*, 1907. Ossian Dyfed died on 24 September 1916 in Shortlands, Kent.  
... and one other interesting fact: In 1911 the family was served by a servant maid by the name of Lisette Schmidt, from Germany.

John survived the war but died on 23 December 1946, aged 53. He is buried at Manordeifi (St. David) Churchyard. John does not seem to be commemorated in Cardigan.

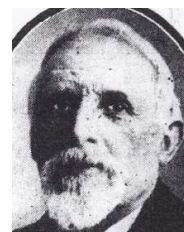

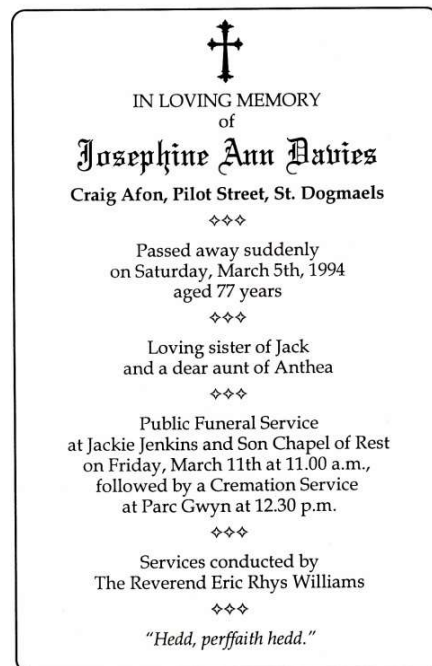

Lewis was born in Cardigan in 1888, the son of John and Elizabeth Davies. His father worked as a coal hewer at Penrhiwceiber and his mother, who was a midwife, had joined him with their children by 1901. Lewis married Alice Maud Bowditch in 1908 and the couple set up home at 28, Church Street, Penrhiwceiber, where he worked as a miner. He enlisted at Aberdare into the 8th Battalion, Royal Welsh Fusiliers. The battalion was attached to 40 Brigade, 13th (Western) Division, and embarked for the Mediterranean in June 1915, landing at Cape Helles, Gallipoli from 6 July 1915, to relieve the 29th Division. The division returned to Mudros at the end of the month before landing at ANZAC Cove from 3 August 1915 to assist the Australians in a forthcoming offensive. Lewis was killed in action at ANZAC on 16 August 1915, aged 27. He has no known grave and is commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Gallipoli.

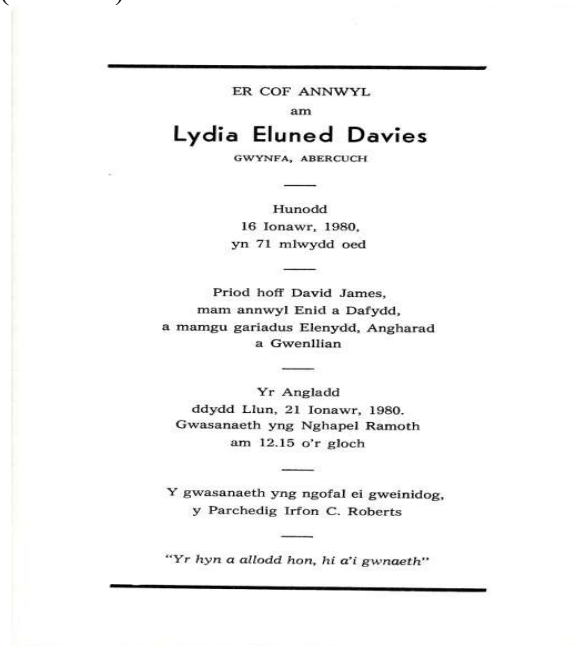

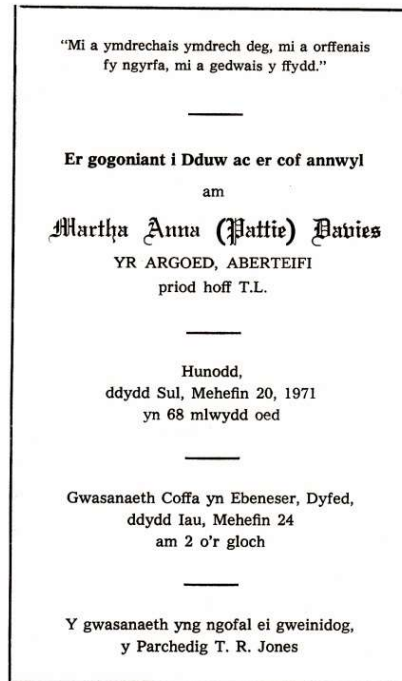

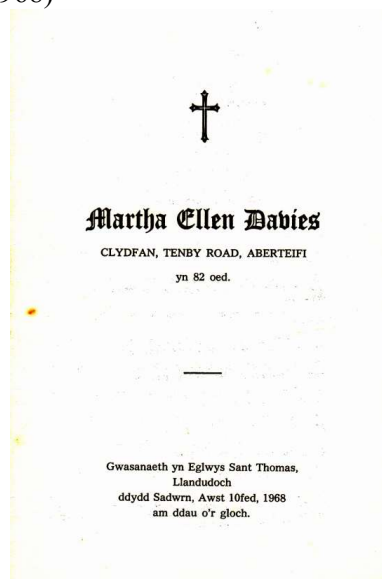
