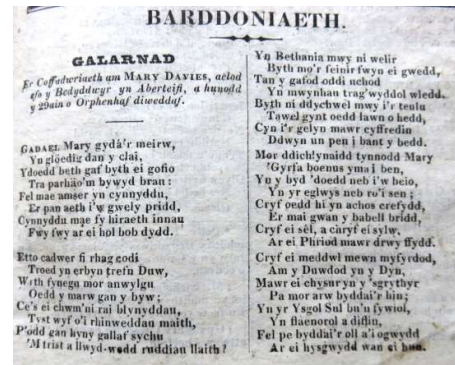

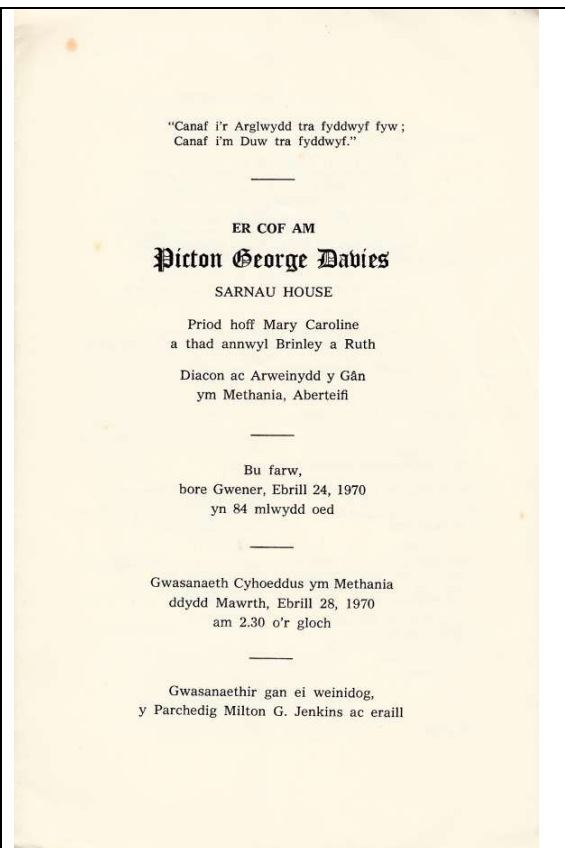

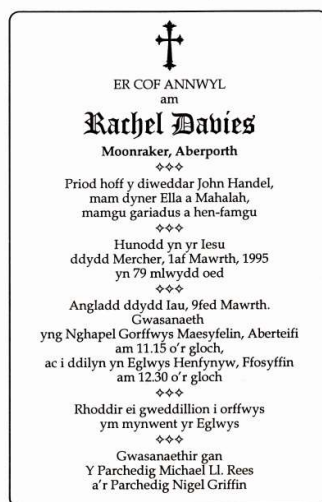

In 1846 TD, Bank House, a ship-owner and timber merchant, acted as the secretary of a fund to provide a local lifeboat. In 1848 TD became a Cardigan Borough Councillor and an Alderman of the Borough in 1850. In 1851 he owned shares in the 221 ton Cardigan ship ‘Heatherbell’. TD lived at Bank House 1852-87.

On November 9th 1852 TD became the Mayor of Cardigan. In 1854 TD owned shares in the 24 ton Cardigan ship ‘Maria’. In November 1856 TD was elected an Alderman of the Borough. In 1857 he owned shares in the 251 ton Cardigan ship ‘Mary Ann Newell’. In 1858 TD owned shares in the 57 ton Cardigan ship ‘Hero’.

On March 19th 1860 TD joined the newly-created Cardigan Company of Rifle Volunteers. He had the rank of Lieutenant. TD became the Mayor of Cardigan on November 9th 1860 and was re-elected to that office a year later and again in November 1862. In 1861 the 251 ton Cardigan ship ‘Mary Ann Newell’, was transferred to new owners, but TD remained a shareholder. In 1863 TD purchased shares in the 919 ton Cardigan ship ‘Goliah’. The ship was lost soon afterwards and another of his vessels, the ‘Mary Ann Newell’, vanished that year after sailing from Pwllheli. TD lived here in 1864 – as the tenant of his cousin, David Davies of Castle Green (Cardigan Castle).

“On Thursday morning last, at an early hour, the inhabitants of this town were busily engaged in decorating the streets with banners/flags, wreaths, &c., to celebrate and honour the happy event of the marriage of their much respected and active mayor, Thomas Davies, Esq., to Miss Jenkins, of St. Mary's-street, daughter of the late Griffith Jenkins, Esq., of Pantirion, and sister to Richard David Jenkins, Esq. of the Priory, in this town. At eleven o'clock the ceremony took place in St. Mary's Church. The marriage service was performed by the Rev. Parry Thomas, Rector of Llanmaes, brother-in-law of the bride. The bride's maids were Miss Mary Anne Jenkins, and Miss Margaret Jenkins, of the Priory, and Miss Jenkins, late of Kilbronne, and the bridegroom's men were D. G. Davies, Esq., Castle-green, and R. Ll. James, Esq., Pantsaeson...” *Welshman* 10.6.1864

In 1865 TD owned shares in the 148 ton Cardigan ship ‘Sarah Anne’. On May 18th 1866 Capt. TD of Bank House and Capt. James Ellis arrived in Quebec with the Cardigan vessels “Sublime” and “Triton”. In 1867 he was the sole owner of the 297 ton Cardigan ship ‘Black Swan’.

In 1867 Alderman TD (“Master Tom”) leased a plot of ground at Glanteifi, St. Dogmaels, to the Board of Admiralty, for the development of a drill hall and artillery battery. He was made the Commanding Officer, with the rank of Lieutenant. In 1869 TD purchased the brand new S. S. ‘Tivy-Side’ Cardigan’s first steam ship.

On September 30th 1870 one of TD’ ships, the “Black Swan”, was lost at Newfoundland (the crew were saved).

In December 1870 TD became a member of the new Cardigan School Board.

In 1871 TD was the sole owner of the Cardigan ship ‘Ann Wilson’. In 1873 he owned shares in the 57 ton Cardigan ship ‘Heatherbell’. That year he was the President of the Annual Cardigan Agricultural Show. From May 8th 1876 TD was a major shareholder in the new ‘Cardigan Mercantile Company’. In 1876 Thomas Davies & Company owned the S. S. “Tivyside” a 65 ton steam vessel.

Thomas Davies died in London on August 1st 1887 aged 63 years.

ALDERMAN DAVIES.

The sad news of the death of Alderman Thomas Davies, of Bank House, which occurred in London on Monday night, reached the town early on Tuesday morning. Though the news was not unexpected, it being known that Alderman Davies had been for some time in ill-health, and had submitted to a very painful and dangerous operation, yet the intelligence cast a deep gloom over the town and neighbourhood.

The deceased gentleman had had business connections with the town for many years, was the oldest member of the Town Council and had, during the last 40 years, filled the office of Mayor no less than six times – in 1852, 1861, 1862, and 1863, and was elected for 1885-6 on account of the opening of the railway to the town He was a magistrate for the borough, as well as for the counties of Cardigan and Pembroke; a member of the School Board, and chairman' of the Burial Board chairman of the Assessment Committee, the Gas Company, the Tivyside Steamboat Company, and the Wharf Company managing director of the Cardigan Mercantile Company, a director of the Whitland and Cardigan Railway Company, &c., &c. All his multifarious duties he discharged in a very satisfactory manner, proving himself in every capacity a thorough man of business. His demise has cut asunder the only link which connected the past with the present, especially with respect to municipal matters. He always used to pride himself on being a Cardigan boy, bred and born, and Cardigan people reciprocated the feeling, and were proud of and looked up to him. His presence will be missed very much, even by those who differed from him in opinions, but at the same time respected him as a man of integrity and deep convictions—a man who aimed at doing what was right. Deceased, who was 65 years of age, was a staunch Churchman and a Conservative.

The funeral took place on (Friday) at noon. The procession was led by the Oddfellows, of which society Mr. Davies had been a member since the commencement, with the Mayor in his robes, and the members of the Corporation, the Oddfellows, in black scarves, the members of the School Board, the members of the Burial Board (of which the deceased was chairman), and the clergy of the town and neighbourhood, the hearse, the mourning carriages, and the general public, of whom there was a general representation. Altogether the funeral was the largest seen in Cardigan for many years...”

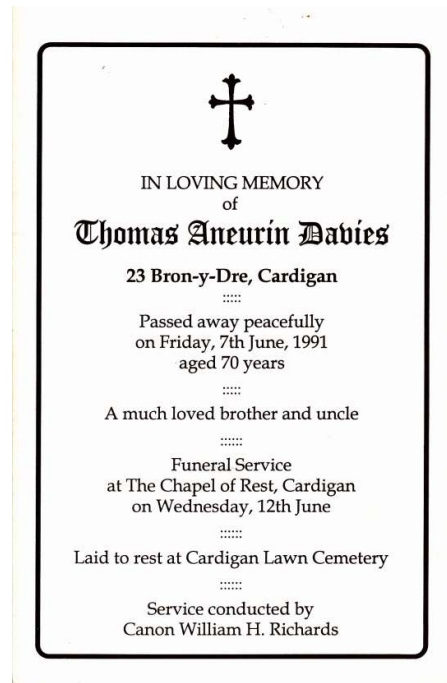


Thomas Davies opening the Railway 1886

On 3 December 1917, Dowlais was torpedoed by German submarine UB-48, and sank off Cape de Fer, Algeria, while on route from Greece for Bona and the Clyde carrying a cargo of copper ore. Thomas was killed in the sinking. He was 24 years old, and is commemorated on the Tower Hill Memorial, London.

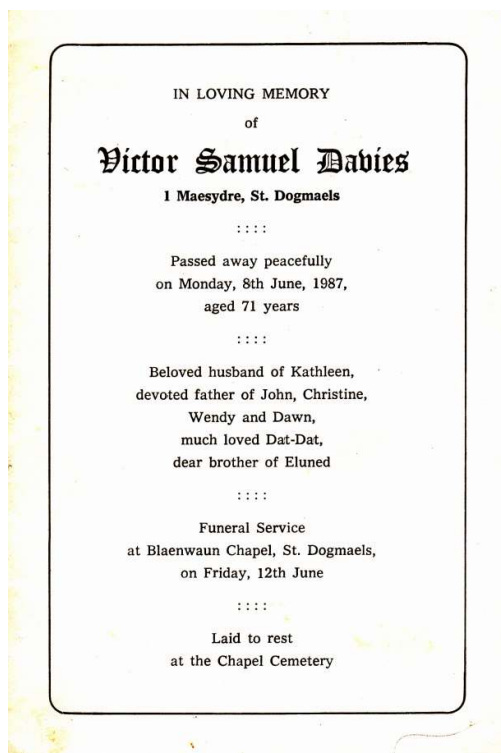

In August 1915 Tom Davies, son of William, was wounded at Gallipoli, and another son, Gwyn Davies, was killed before the end of the Great War. On 28th May 1934, William Davies, J.P., died.

His son, Tom, took over the business but died on 15 May 1935 aged 43. William Davies' remaining children ran the business until 24th October 1958, when Miss Eleanor G. Davies held a clear-out sale.

In 1959 the building became 'Gina's' ladies' fashion shop.

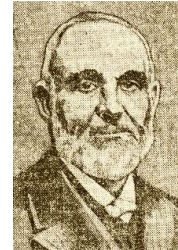

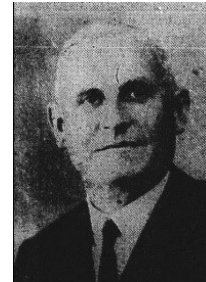

He had originally enlisted at Cardiff into the 20th Battalion, Welsh Regiment on 27 November 1915, and on 20 December 1916 transferred to the Royal Garrison Artillery. He embarked for France on 30 April 1917, joining No. 6 Fire Command, but after only two months in France took ill and was invalided home. On 5 October 1918 William was discharged from the army after having been deemed unfit for military service, and he died of a heart condition on 18 December 1918, aged 21. He was buried in Pontypridd (Glyntaff) Cemetery. William does not appear to be commemorated locally.

The family later moved to Blaenwaun Farm, Mount, Cardigan. William trained as an engineer, and served aboard the Liverpool registered tanker, S.S. Beacon Light. On 19 February 1918 she was fifteen miles off Scotland, en route from Liverpool with a cargo of fuel oil when she was torpedoed and sunk by the German submarine U-91, with the loss of 33 lives. William was 25 years old when he died that day, and is commemorated on the Tower Hill Memorial, London.

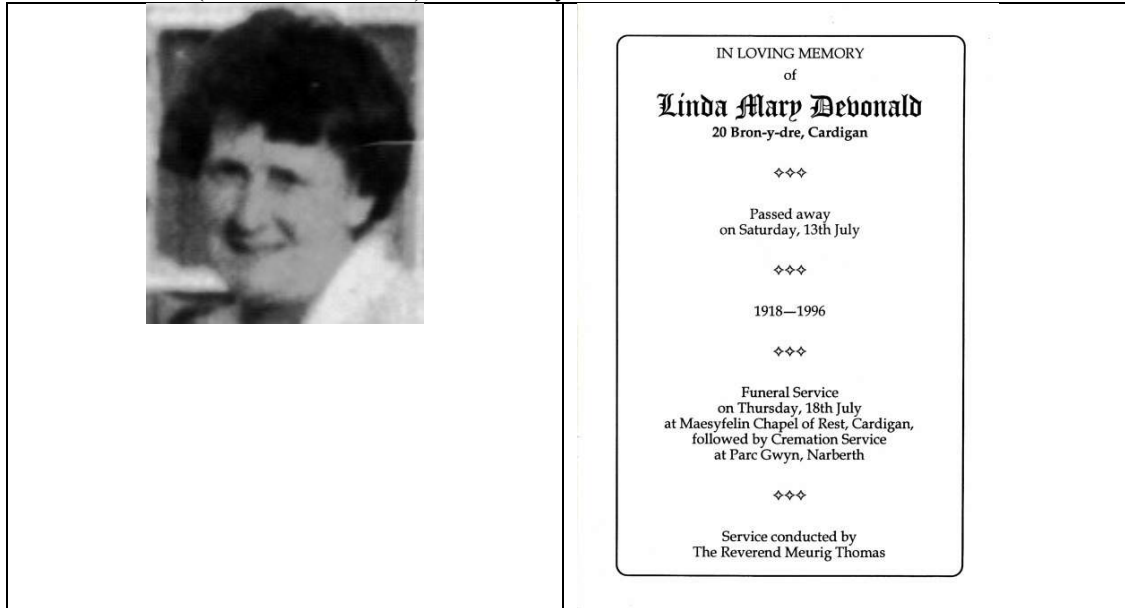

He resided with his uncle at Star Shop, Cardigan prior to the war, and enlisted at Carmarthen into the army. David was posted to the 1st Battalion, King's Shropshire Light Infantry, which was attached to 16 Brigade, 6th Division. The Division had been in France since 10 September 1914, and had fought at Hooge. David joined the battalion in France on 28 September 1915, and fought on the Somme the following year. The following year, 1917, saw them at Arras, where they fought at the Battle of Hill 70, and then during the Battle of Cambrai later in the year. In the spring of 1918 the Division was one of those hit by the German Offensive on the Somme, which had been launched on 21 March, and the Division took part in the Battle of St Quentin. They were moved from the line, and went to Flanders to rest, but the following month the Germans launched another offensive on the Lys, and the Division saw heavy fighting in the following days. During August 1918 the Allies had recovered sufficiently to be able to launch their own attacks on the Germans, and after a brilliant victory at Villers Brettoneux on 8 August, attacks were launched at Albert. The 6th Division took part in the Advance in Flanders, before moving south, where they took part in the advance on the Hindenburg Line. David was killed in action here on 18 September 1918. He was 23 years old, and is buried at Savy British Cemetery, France.
