By 1891 No. 7 St Mary's Stwas non-residential.

On 23rd June 1891 C. E. D. Morgan-Richardson became the head of a steering
 committee to build a new Intermediate School in the town. On 12th May 1892 May Rita
 Constance Morgan-Richardson was born – daughter of C. E. D. Morgan-Richardson. On
 9th November 1897 C. E. D. Morgan-Richardson became the Mayor of Cardigan. Before
 the end of the year he had founded a rowing club.

On 18th February 1898 improvements were under way at Netpool Gardens, at his
 expense. In November 1898 C. E. D. Morgan-Richardson was re-elected Mayor of
 Cardigan.

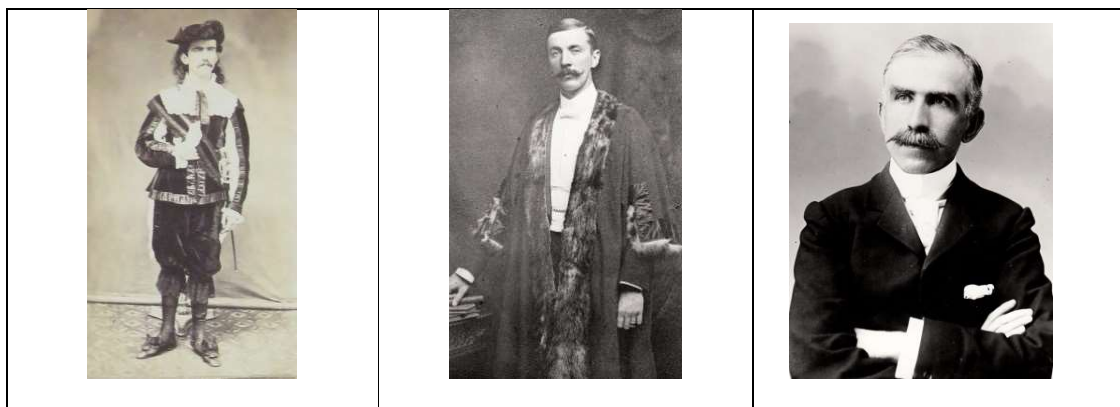
In 1899 C. E. D. Morgan-Richardson demolished various properties he had acquired and
 built a new street linking Priory Street and St. Mary's Street. He named it Morgan Street
 after his former partner and benefactor.

In November 1899 he was re-elected Mayor again. In October 1900 C. E. D. Morgan-
 Richardson refused the offer of the mayoralty. No. 7 was non-residential in 1901. On 14th
 May 1902 C. E. D. Morgan-Richardson opened the King & Alexandra Gardens at St.

Dogmaels. In 1912 C. L. E. Morgan-Richardson was admitted into the firm. On 29th
 September 1913 Charles Evan Davis Morgan-Richardson, died aged 56. In 1914-43

Charles Lethbridge Ernest Morgan-Richardson was the senior solicitor of the firm. On 24th
 May 1940 C. L. E. Morgan-Richardson presented a copy of the town charter to the
 Cardigan Borough Council. The firm was still trading here in 1940-2013. On 29th

December 1961 Charles Lethbridge Ernest Morgan-Richardson died aged 73.

Arthur David Morris grew up at Claverley, 2 Gordon Terrace, the son of Arthur Owen and Martha Jane (nee Wigley) and worked as an apprentice at James' ironmongery at Pendre. In 1929, at the age of 21, he emigrated to Canada. He served in the army for two and half years before he eventually settled in Blairmore, Alberta, where he worked as a miner. He joined the Communist Party of Canada in 1933.

Arthur Morris left Canada in 1936 to enrol in the International Lenin School in Moscow. After the outbreak of the Spanish Civil War the students of the Lenin School departed for Spain, and Arthur made his own way across Europe sending postcards home from Warsaw, Paris and Perpignan. He crossed into Spain and joined the American contingent who were forming the Abraham Lincoln battalion at Albacete, midway between Madrid and Valencia.

The battle that raged in the Jarama Valley to the south of Madrid in February 1937 was one of the most ferocious of the war with the Fascists deploying German artillery.

In February 1937, at the age of 29 Arthur Morris met his death in the olive groves of the Jarama Valley, south of Madrid.

In May 1937 news of Arthur's death finally reached his mother and made front page headlines of the ***Tivyside Advertiser***, competing for space with the Coronation; 'Killed in

Spain –Cardigan Man Dies Fighting for Spanish Government'. His mother described him as a "beautiful boy, always fighting for what he thought to be right".

He had emigrated to Australia, and enlisted at Newcastle, N.S.W. on 9 May 1916 into the 36th Battalion, Australian Imperial Force. John embarked at Sydney aboard the HMAT Anchises, and disembarked at Devonport on 11 October that year. On 11 November 1916 his papers show that he marched to join the 3rd Australian Division, proceeding to France on 22 November. John was wounded at Ypres on 11 July 1917, and was brought to the 10th Australian Field Ambulance, where he died of Wounds that same day. He was 45 years old, and is buried in Kandahar Farm Cemetery near Ypres.

William was the son of Jane Morris, of 6, Osborne Terrace, Brynmill, Swansea. He was
 raised by his grandparents, Richard and Esther Morgan, at 6, Tivy Terrace, Cardigan. He
 served in the Mercantile Marine as Third Engineer aboard the S.S. Blagdon. William died
 in Greenwich on 22 October 1916, aged 22. He was brought home for burial in Cardigan
 Cemetery. He is not commemorated by the CWGC because his death was not due to
 enemy action, but the SS Blagdon was later torpedoed and sunk in 1917.

He served with 540 Squadron, Royal Air Force, which was an elite unit, equipped with the De Havilland Mosquito. Thomas was killed when his Mosquito was lost on 3 May 1943. He was 26 years old, and is commemorated on the Runnymede Memorial, Surrey. Thomas is not commemorated at Cardigan.

Motylak, Jan Korporal, Polish Forces.

Jan was born in Poland in 1900 and came to Britain with the Polish Forces following the German Blitzkrieg. He served with the 11th Baon, S.K. which was situated at Oulton Park Camp, near Tarporley, Cheshire. The site of the camp is now a famous motor racing

- circuit. Jan died at Cardigan on 15 February 1947, aged 47, and is buried in Cardigan Cemetery.
