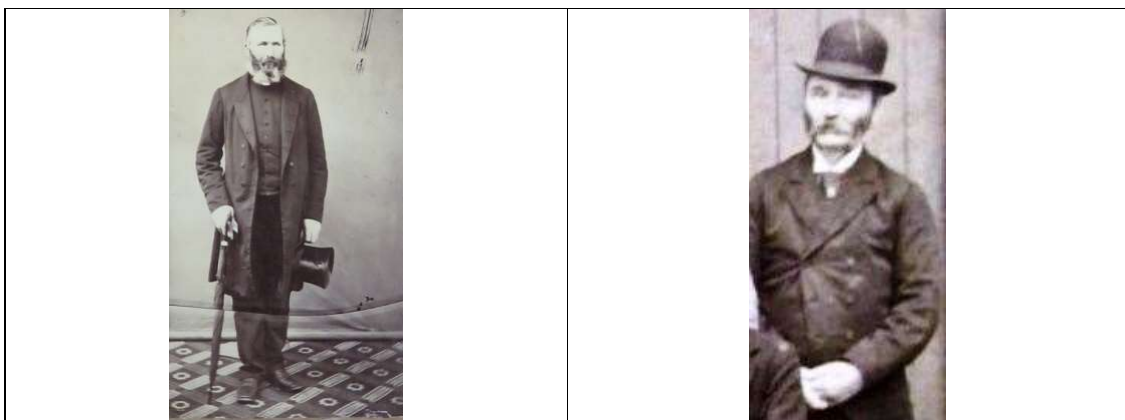

On 8 August 1915 the Battalion landed in France as part of the 26th Division, and just nine days later moved into 1 Brigade, 1st Division. The Division fought at the Battle of Loos, before moving to the Somme, fighting in most of the battles which made up the Somme Offensive of 1916. In 1917 they moved to Flanders, and fought at the Second Battle of Passchendaele, where David was unfortunately killed in Action, on 30 September 1917 aged only 20. He is buried in Buffs Road Cemetery, near Ypres.

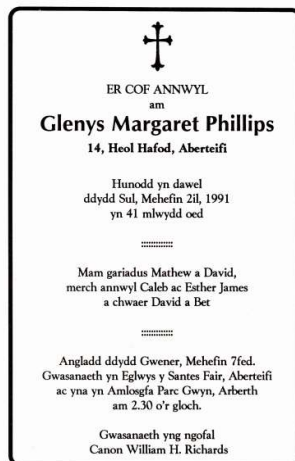

Gwilym was the son of William and Elizabeth Phillips, of **21, St. Mary Street**, Cardigan. He
enlisted into the Devonshire Regiment, and landed in France on 11 January 1917.
Gwilym gained a commission into the 4th Battalion, Gloucestershire Regiment on 30
October 1917, and was attached to the 1/8th Battalion, Lancashire Fusiliers, which was
attached to 125 Brigade, 42nd (East Lancashire) Division. He joined the battalion at
Givenchy, where it remained until moving back south in early 1918. Here the Division
faced the German Spring Offensive of 21 March on the Somme, and fought in the Battle
of Bapaume, and then at Arras. The offensive stalled for several months, until an

Australian victory at Villers Brettoneux on 8 August saw the tide of war turn. The British attacked the German lines on the Somme on 21 August, with the 42nd Division in the line, and began the great offensive that was eventually to end the war. The Division fought at the Battle of Albert, then the Battle of Bapaume, and on to the Canal du Nord. Gwilym was killed in action here on 13 October 1918. He was 22 years old, and is buried at Romeries Communal Cemetery Extension, France.

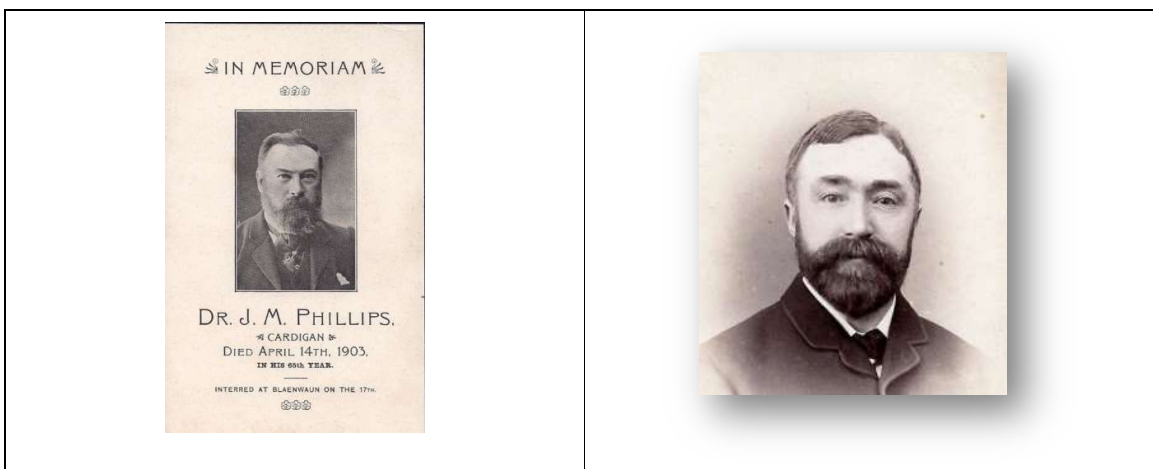

DEATH OF DR. PHILLIPS J.P. OF CARDIGAN.

On Tuesday morning at his residence, Bank House, Cardigan, after a lingering illness, Dr. James Mathias Phillips passed away peacefully in his 65th year.... Deceased was much respected by all classes, especially the poor, who always found in him a friend in need. He was J.P. for the borough and county of Cardigan, councillor, alderman, and mayor of Cardigan, district medical officer and public vaccinator and workhouse medical officer for the Cardigan Union, for a period surgeon to the Royal Naval Reserve and Volunteers, and deacon of the Blaenywaun Baptist Church, St. Dogmell's where his grandfather, the late Rev. David Phillips, was pastor for many years.

Some eight years ago he was unanimously elected president of the Pembrokeshire Baptist Association but owing to multifarious duties he declined the honour. He was in practice at Cardigan for over 30 years. As a Nonconformist, Liberal, and temperance advocate he held deep convictions, but was never intolerant towards those who differed from him. He leaves a widow and a grown-up son and daughter. The son, who is a fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons, holds the office of resident surgeon of the native hospital at Cairo, but has come home on account of his late father's illness. The funeral which will be a public one, will take place this afternoon and the interment is to be in Blaenywaun Burying ground... 17.4.1903, *Pembrokeshire Herald*

This is what the *British Medical Journal* has to say about him:

He was born at Taibach, Glam. on July 28th 1871. In 1881 he was living in 10 Priory St. From Epsom College he went to Caius College, Cambridge, in 1889, obtaining first-class honours in Part I of the Natural Science Tripos of 1892, and then entered as a student at St Bartholomew's Hospital. He qualified as MRCS, LRCP, in 1894, took the MB and B.Ch Camb degrees, in 1895, and in 1897 obtained diploma of FRCS Eng. In 1903 he proceeded MD and obtained MRCP and in 1909 elected Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of London. He practised for a while at Cardigan. (c.1898)

His career in Egypt began when he was appointed resident surgical officer of the Kasr-el-Aini Hospital Cairo. Elected Professor of Medicine in the Royal School of Medicine, Cairo. During WW1 he held a temporary commission as lieutenant-colonel RAMC, and commanded the British Red Cross Hospital at Giza; he was mentioned four times in dispatches. From 1914 to 1917 he held the appointment of physician to H.H. la Hussein Kamel, Sultan of Egypt, and for his services was made a member of the Orders of the Nile and of the Medjidie.

He made a remarkable collection of old Arab glass weights and coins, and died at his house in Cairo in January, 1927.

He contributed articles on tropical medicine to various medical journals including: "Phlebotomus Fever" in Bryan and Archibald's Practice of Medicine in the Tropics, v Amoebiasis and the Dysenteries, 8vo, London, 1915.

He served with 311 Battery, 90 Light Anti Aircraft Regiment, Royal Artillery. The battery took part in the North African campaign, and it was there that Victor was killed, on 20 April 1943, aged 27. He is buried at Medjez-El-Bab War Cemetery, Tunisia. Victor is not commemorated at Cardigan.

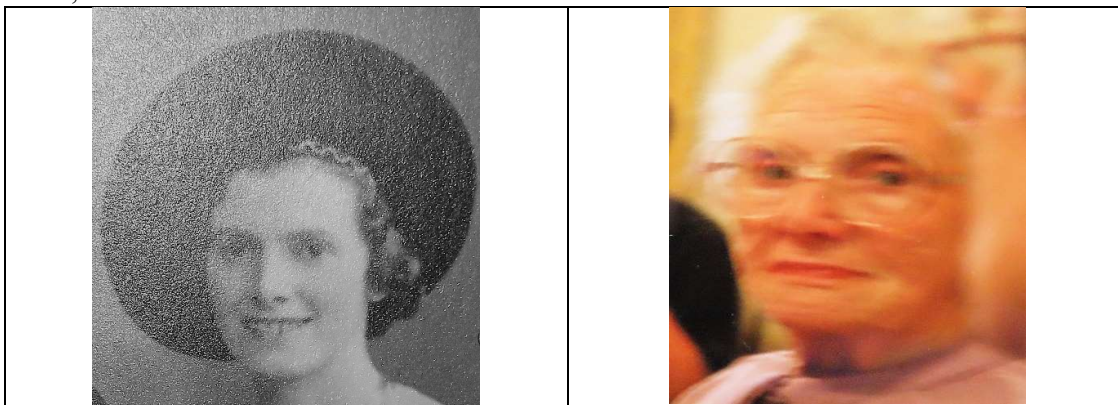

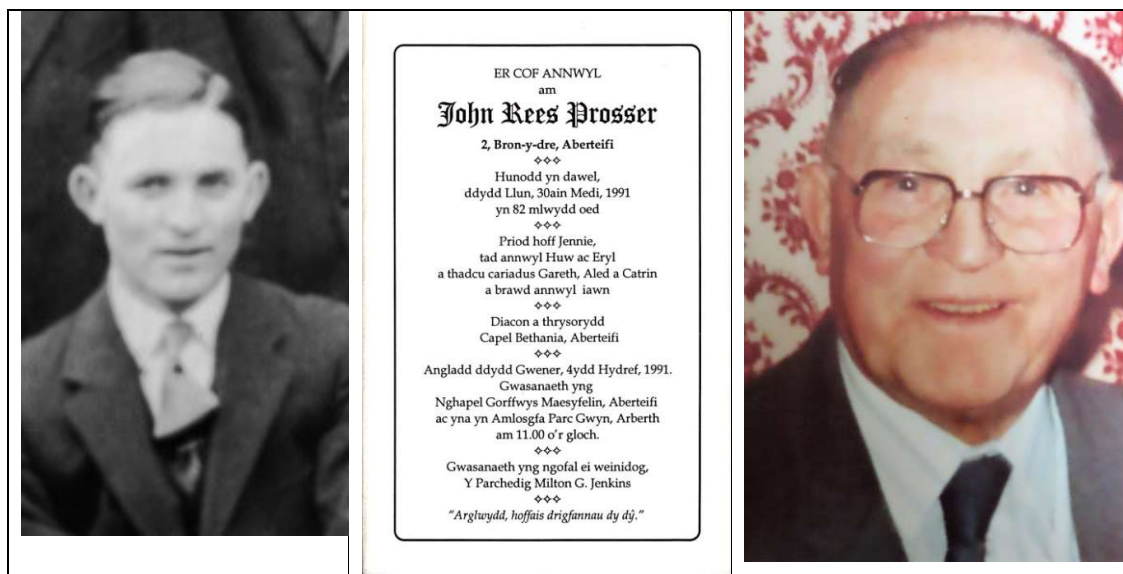

Joseph was born at Cardigan in 1881, the son of Esther Protheroe, a sailors wife. He worked as a miner at Ystradfodwg prior to the war, and enlisted at Ferndale into the 7th Battalion, Somerset Light Infantry. The battalion was attached to 61 Brigade, 20th (Light) Division, which landed in France on 26 July 1915, moving to the Fleurbaix Sector for trench familiarisation and training. When the Battle of Loos was launched on 25 September 1915 the Division fought a diversionary attack towards Fromelles. Later that year they moved north, and fought at the Battle of Mount Sorrel alongside the Canadian Corps. They then fought through the Somme Offensive. Joseph was killed at the Battle of Delville Wood on 1 September 1916. He was 35 years old, and is buried at Dantzig Alley British Cemetery, Mametz, France. He had been awarded the Military Medal just previous to his death.

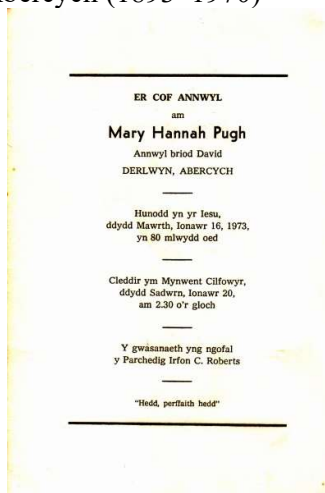
