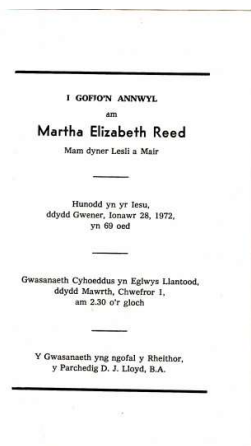

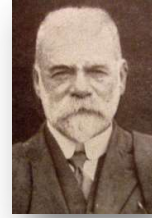

 Benjamin was the son of Evan and Mary Rees, of 5, Church Street, Cardigan. He enlisted at  
 Aberdare into the Royal Artillery, and was posted to the 13th Mountain Battery, Royal  
 Garrison Artillery. The battery was armed with 3.7 inch howitzers, and joined VIII  
 Mountain Brigade, R.G.A. at Catterick on 11 July 1917. The Battery sailed from  
 Southampton on 23 August 1917 and concentrated at Sidi Bishr in Egypt. Benjamin took  
 ill, and died in hospital at Alexandria on 31 October 1918, aged 24. He is buried at  
 Alexandria (Hadra) War Memorial Cemetery, Egypt. His brother John also fell.

A native of Llandysul, he was educated at Gwilym Marles School, and William James school, Llandysul. Unitarian; Carmarthen Presbyterian College under Principal Evans; Aberystwyth College for 1 year where BA degree 1<sup>st</sup> divis (London). London Univ MA Classics. Oxford – awarded Hibbert Scholarship which he carried to Berlin and Leipsig, where he took his Doctorate in Philosophy and Celtic. Finally he went to Paris where he studied for six months at the Sorbonne. Appointed in 1897–1932; Married Elizabeth M Davies eldest daughter of Rev John Davies, Shrewsbury and had 1 son. Headmaster of Cardigan County School for 36 years. After his retirement he moved to Hastings. He had been unwell for some time, and on medical advice decided to take a holiday in Sicily. Whilst on the train at Lyon, in France he passed away. His wife was with him at the time. His remains were cremated in France.

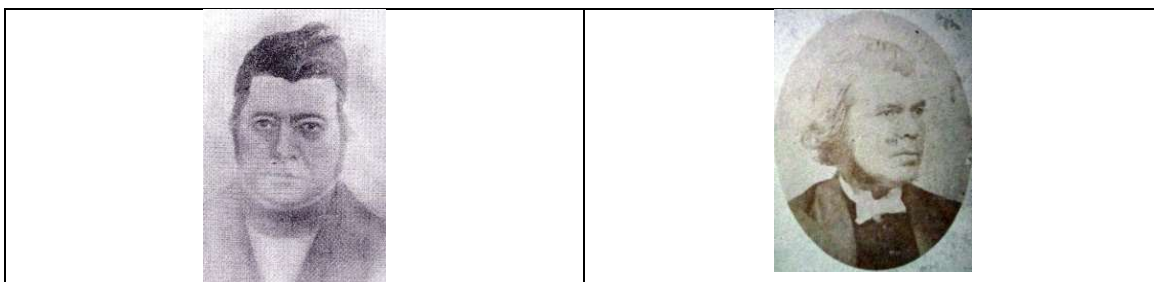

 Rees, of Cardigan. He served with the Merchant Navy aboard the MV British  
 Resource, a London registered tanker. On 14 March 1942, she was torpedoed by the  
 German submarine U-124 north of Bermuda, caught fire and sank, with the loss of 45  
 lives. David was 27 years old when he died that day, and is commemorated on the  
 Tower Hill Memorial, London.

Benjamin was the son of Joshua and Patsy Richards, of Union Terrace, St. Dogmaels. He enlisted at Treorchy into the Monmouth Regiment, with the service number 47085. In early 1916, Battalion Machine Gunners were transferred into newly formed Machine Gun Companies, and Benjamin joined the 59th Battalion, M.G.C., joining the 20th (Light) Division on 3 March 1916. The Division fought at the Battle of Mount Sorrel during June, 1916 alongside the Canadians, then were moved south to the Somme, fighting at Delville Wood, Guillemont, Flers, Morval and Le Transloy. They moved north to Ypres, taking part in several stages of the Battle of Passchendaele, and also fought at the Battle of Cambrai, and the 1918 Battles of St. Quentin, the Somme Crossings and Rosieres. Benjamin was taken Prisoner by the Germans at some stage in 1918, and Died in captivity on 3 July 1918, aged 25. He is buried in Niederzwehren Cemetery, Germany.

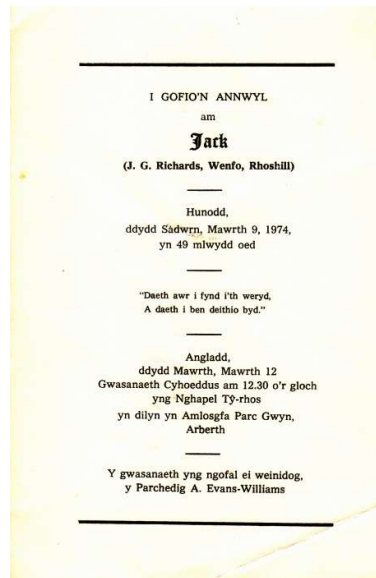
**Richards, George Ivor Milton Phillips Private, 200484, Welsh Regiment.**

George was the son of Captain David and Annie Ida Richards, of Kelvin, Cardigan. He enlisted at Cardigan into the 1/4th Battalion, Welsh Regiment, which was the local Territorial Battalion, attached to 159 Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division. The Division landed at Cape Helles, Gallipoli, on 9 August 1915, and was immediately thrown into action, spending the next few days in isolated pockets, fighting against a Turkish counter-attack during the Battle of Sari Bair, and then at the Attack on Scimitar Hill. The Division remained here throughout the coming months, and suffered severe losses in manpower strength during the great November 1915 blizzard on Gallipoli, when its total strength was reduced to less than that of a full-strength Brigade. On 11 December 1915 the Division was evacuated to Mudros, and by 23 December 1915 were moved to Egypt. They remained on the Suez Canal Defences for the next twelve months, where it took part in

operations against the Sultan of Darfur, and in March 1917 took part in the advance into Palestine. George was killed here at the First Battle of Gaza, on 26 March 1917, passing away in the arms of a fellow soldier. He was 23 years old, and is commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial, Israel.

**Richbell, Thomas Richard** Thomas was born at Stratford, Essex in 1882, the son of Thomas and Emily Richbell. He worked for HM Customs and Excise at Cardigan prior to the war, and married Myfanwy Morgan, of Cardigan, at Bradford on 5 April 1907. The couple later resided at Gwalia, Clynderwen, after having renewed their vows at Cardigan in 1908. Thomas looks to have been posted as missing presumed killed in France on 15 October 1916, and probate was left to Myfanwy. The CWGC however records Thomas as having died on 5 February 1919, aged 42, and being buried at Richmond Cemetery, Surrey. His next of kin was shown as his wife, Alice Emma Richbell, of 8, James Cottages, Kew Rd., Kew, while the last that can be found about Myfanwy is her sailing for

- Sri Lanka. Did Myfanwy emigrate, believing her husband was dead, when he was actually a POW, or is it a case of two men with the same uncommon name, serving with the RAVC?

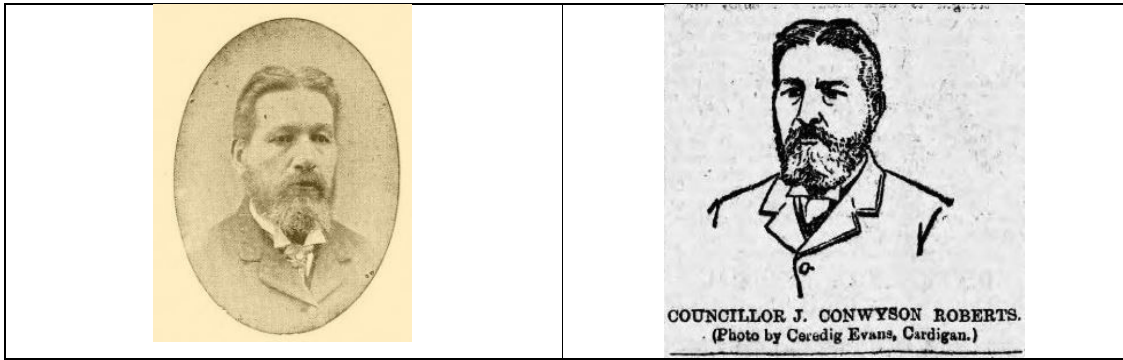

John Roberts was a coal merchant referred to at this address in the 1880s and 1890s.

His son William Roberts, who was born here, later composed the hymn tune "Bryngogarth", named after the home of the minister of Cardigan's Bethania Baptist Chapel - the minister's house was located on Napier Street in the town.

Tom Rees yn brifathro – Yr Athro Thomas Rhys, BA, Bangor ar ôl hynny. Wedyn aeth WR at ddyn o'r enw Griffith Griffiths, Castle Street I ddysgu ei grefft fel gwneuthurwr dodrefn. Bu'n gweithio wedyn gyda David Lewis, Llanifor, Penyparc, dros y ffordd y tu ol i'r Eagle Inn.

Bu yma am rai blynyddoedd, nes gorfod ohono oherwydd gwendid corf roi heibio cefft saer. Yna bu gyda Tom Thomas, mewn siop fechan, lle heddiw saif siop hardd y Cyng Jack Jenkins, Pendre. Ar ôl blynyddoedd cychwynodd fasnach iddo'i hun yn Heol y Bont, a pharhaodd felly hyd derfyn oes. Tynnwyd y siop i lawr c. 1933. Safai gyferbyn a Heol y Cei, yr ochr arall i'r ffordd.

Nid oedd yn nodedig am ei ddoniau cyhoeddus, ond ni bu neb erioed teyrngarach nag ef mewn eglwys. Un o'r rhai mwyaf addfwyn, diniwed a thyner gallon, ac eto, pan fyddai galw am sefyll dros egwyddor yr oedd mor ddewr a llew, ac yn uchel ei brotest yn erbyn pechod ymhob ffurf.



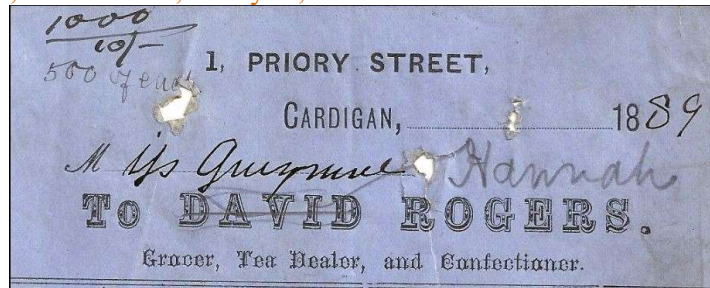
