Albert J. Volk was born at Gwbert, Card.shire, Wales. He arrived on Pitcairn in 1881 as a result of the  
 shipwreck of the Acadia, a British ship outward bound from San Francisco. He married Mary Ann  
 Young, daughter of Simon Young and Mary Buffett Christian, on September 8, 1881, on Pitcairn  
 Island. After three years, he and his wife left Pitcairn to live in Wales. The children of Albert and  
 Mary Ann Young were Percy Volk and Walter Volk.

 1884, they took Earnest with them to live in Wales.

**Volk, Walter A.**, [thePeerage.com](http://thePeerage.com). Walter A. Volk was born on Pitcairn Island in either 1884 or 1885. He was the son of Albert J. Volk and Mary Ann Young. Walter's father, Albert J. Volk, arrived on Pitcairn in 1881 a crew member of the shipwrecked British ship Acadia. After three years, Albert and Mary Ann left Pitcairn to live in Wales, and it is assumed they took Walter, and his brother Percy Volk with them..

**Young, Mary Ann**, [thePeerage.com](http://thePeerage.com).

Mary Ann Young was born on Pitcairn Island on June 5, 1855. She was the daughter of Simon Young and Mary Buffett Christian. She married Albert John Volk (1857-1917) on September 8, 1881, on Pitcairn Island. He was born in Newport, Monmouthshire, Wales. She was among the second wave of returnees from Norfolk to Pitcairn in 1864. She died on April 18, 1887, at age 31 at Card.shire, Wales, from consumption. Albert and Mary Ann had two sons: Ernest Percy, born 1883 on Pitcairn, and Walter, born 1885 on Pitcairn. Mary Ann Young was a sister to Rosalind Amelia Young-Nield.

**Young, Rosalind Amelia**

She was the daughter of Simon Young and Mary Buffett Christian. She married David Nield on November 27, 1907, at Auckland, New Zealand. She died on February 1, 1924, at age 70 on Pitcairn Island. From November 27, 1907, her married name became Nield. She was a writer and a teacher. She was among the 2nd wave of returnees from Norfolk to Pitcairn in 1864. At the age of 24, she was asked to write an article about Pitcairn life. At that time, by her own admission, she had never worn shoes in her life, swam like a fish ... four miles at a stretch, and was an excellent performer on the organ. By 1894, she was serving as Pitcairn's editor, historical chronicler of the island, and primary school teacher.
