Owen was the son of Owen and Catherine Williams, of 7, Queen's Terrace, Cardigan. He enlisted at Cardigan into the 1/4th Battalion, Welsh Regiment, which was the local Territorial Battalion, attached to 159 Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division. The Division landed at Cape Helles, Gallipoli, on 9 August 1915, and was immediately thrown into action, spending the next few days in isolated pockets, fighting against a Turkish counter-attack during the Battle of Sari Bair, and then at the Attack on Scimitar Hill. Owen was badly wounded during the initial fighting, and was evacuated by hospital ship to Egypt. He died at Chatby Military Hospital on 30 August 1915, aged 20, and is buried at Alexandria (Chatby) Military and War Memorial Cemetery, Egypt. His brother, David also fell.

William John Williams later lived here and kept his solicitor's office at the property. Of Penralltddu, Llantood, he stood as a candidate in the 1891 Cardigan Municipal Election. On 9th November 1896 he was elected Mayor of Cardigan. On 12th March 1897 a silver cradle was presented to him by the Corporation to celebrate the birth of his son. He remained resident for a number of years, but later built a house to the north east of the town and named it Penralltddu after his former family home. He died on 14th February 1942 aged 78.

In 1889 the solicitor William John Williams, originally from Penralltddu, Llantood, went into business – possibly here, after serving his articles with Ivor Evans at No. 3 Green Street. From 1891 until 1926 William John Williams, a solicitor, traded here. In 1891 W. J. Williams of No. 1 High Street and Penralltddu, Llantood, stood as a candidate in the Cardigan Municipal Election and was duly elected. No. 1 was non-residential at the time of the 1891 Census. On December 3rd 1895 William John Williams, a solicitor and an agent for Royal Insurance, was married to Mary Ellen Williams, the third daughter of Mr. S. Williams of Dyffryn Mills in Velindre, Carmarthenshire. On November 9th 1896 W. J. Williams was elected to serve as the Mayor of Cardigan.

'Cardigan Observer' of November 14th 1896:

“...THE NEW MAYOR OF CARDIGAN.

Councillor W. J. Williams, the Mayor of Cardigan for the ensuing year, is a solicitor, the only son of Mr Thos. Williams, Pen'ralltddu, Llantood, farmer, and was born on the 18th May, 1864, at Manian Fawr, within the borough. Having received his education at the Cilgerran National School and the Cardigan Grammar School, he was articled in Mr Ivor Evans of the firm of Messrs. Asa and Ivor Evans, solicitors, Cardigan, and admitted a solicitor in 1889. In the same year he commenced practising in Cardigan, where he carries on a very successful business. He first entered the Town Council in 1891, and on his second return headed the poll by a very large majority. He has held the chairmanship of the Llantood School Board for three years, and was returned unopposed as the representative of the district of Eglwysrwrw on the Pembrokeshire County Council in 1895, and appointed a member of the Standing Joint Committee for the county and the Tivy Fishery Board. On the 3rd of December last he married Mary Ellen, third daughter of Mr S. Williams, Dyffryn Woollen Mills, Velindre, Llandyssul. Councillor Williams is a Baptist in creed and a Liberal in politics; and, besides, is the youngest gentleman that ever occupied the civic chair of the ancient borough...”

On November 30th 1896 Eleanor E. Williams was born – the daughter of the Mayor William John Williams and his wife. On March 12th 1897 a silver cradle was presented to W. J. Williams by the Corporation, to celebrate his first-born child. The following item appeared in the 'Cardigan & Tivy-Side Advertiser' of March 19th 1897:

“...PRESENTATION OF A SILVER CRADLE TO THE MAYOR.

A special meeting of the corporation, to which the borough officials were invited, was held in the Council Chamber on Friday evening last, its object being to present the beautiful silver cradle, subscribed for by the Aldermen and Councillors, to Mr W J Williams, our popular Mayor, as a memento of the birth of his first-born during his term of office, and as a token of the high regard in which he and the Mayoress are held by all. The members of the council present were Aldermen J M Phillips, MD, Lewis Evans, and O Beynon Evans, Councillors Dan Evans, J C Roberts, B James (Ex-Mayor), Thos. Griffiths, Arthur Clougher, E Mathias, Evan Jenkins, Wm. Rees, and D Ivor Evans. The officials in attendance were Messrs D Morgan Jones, town clerk; Wm. Lewis, treasurer; J R Davies, rate-collector; T Bowen, surveyor; and Thos. Evans, market inspector. The senior alderman, Dr. Phillips, was voted to

preside. The cradle, which was supplied by Messrs. Thomas & Son, Jewellers, High-street, Cardigan, was an extremely handsome affair in solid silver with hood and tassels, supported on four miniature maces fac similes of the ancient silver maces of the corporation; on the sides were the Borough Arms and in front of the ebony plinth on which the cradle stood, was a silver shield surmounted with a Welsh harp upon which was the following inscription:-

“Presented by the Corporation of Cardigan to W J Williams, Esq., Mayor – 1896-97.”

William was the son of John Andrew and Anne Williams of Cardigan. He resided with his wife, Eleanor Williams (nee Williams), at Ivy Cottage, Penybryn, Cilgerran prior to the war, and served with the Mercantile Marine, aboard the S.S. Treveal, a St. Ives registered cargo vessel. On 4 February 1918, Treveal was on route from Algiers for Barrow she was torpedoed by the German submarine U-53 and sunk, off the Skerries, Anglesey. William was amongst 33 men who died aboard her that day. He was 49 years old, and is commemorated on the Tower Hill Memorial, London.

Harry was born at Cardigan in 1890, the son of Joseph and Anna Woodward, of 3, Gloster Row, Cardigan. He enlisted at Cardigan into the 1/4th Battalion, Welsh Regiment, which was the local Territorial Battalion, attached to 159 Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division. The Division landed at Cape Helles, Gallipoli, on 9 August 1915, and was immediately thrown into action, spending the next few days in isolated pockets, fighting against a Turkish counter-attack during the Battle of Sari Bair, and then at the Attack on Scimitar Hill. Harry was killed here on 10 August 1915. He was 22 years old, and is commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Gallipoli.

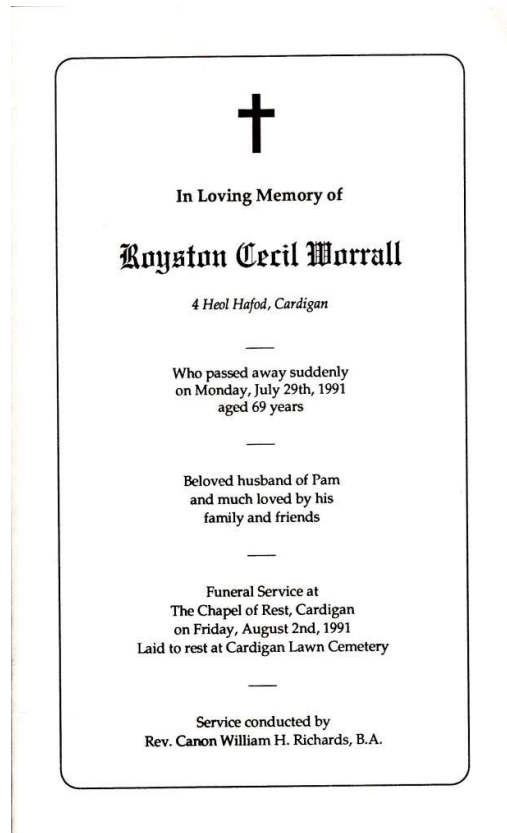

- Albert was the Husband of Mary Lavinia Wyatt, of 6, Queen's Terrace, Cardigan. He enlisted at Cardigan into the 1/4th Battalion, Welsh Regiment, which was the local Territorial Battalion, attached to 159 Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division. The Division landed at Cape Helles, Gallipoli, on 9 August 1915, and was immediately thrown into action, spending the next few days in isolated pockets, fighting against a Turkish counter-attack during the Battle of Sari Bair, and then at the Attack on Scimitar Hill. The Division remained here throughout the coming months, and suffered severe losses in manpower strength during the great November 1915 blizzard on Gallipoli, when its total strength was reduced to less than that of a full-strength Brigade. Albert was invalided home in January 1916 after contracting enteric fever. He never recovered properly, and was discharged from the army as unfit for further overseas on 4 July 1916. Albert succumbed to his illness, and died at Cardigan on 27 October 1918, aged 32. He is buried at Cardigan Cemetery.

Stanley was born on 5 October 1914, the son of Albert George Wyatt and Mary Lavinia Wyatt, of Queen's Terrace, Cardigan. His father had died as a result of his service with the 4th Welsh on 27 October 1918. Stanley enlisted into the Merchant Navy in 1933 and trained as a Marine Engineer. He first served aboard the S.S. Antonio, and during WW2 was posted aboard the S.S. Hardwicke Grange. He was reported lost at sea on 20 October 1940, aged 26, and is not commemorated by the CWGC because his death was not due to military action. His mother Mary had lost her brother John Ernest Williams at sea during WW1.
